This arsonist visited several lodges and they all thought he was a little off. But they did not say anything to each other. This is something we should all be vigilant about and ensure that we voice our concerns with the officers. The Brothers of Leesburg Lodge #58 and Florida has lost so much history in this incident. The history of the lodge over 150 years is all gone.

At our last Masters And Wardens we were provided with encouragement to ensure our building security is good. I know we have had some recent incidents at the building with homeless using the property around the building and will encourage our building committee to look at additional options and features to better protect our property.

The main reason the Arsonist of the Leesburg Lodge #58 fire was caught is because of the camera system they had in place that recorded everything up until the cameras were burnt up. They had clear images of the Arsonist which helped lead to his capture.

Intertwined with that historical event are many brother Masons - nine of the fifty-six signers of the Declaration of Independence were Masons either than or at a later point in their lives: William Ellery; Benjamin Franklin; John Hancock; Joseph Hewes; William Hooper; Robert Treat Paine; Richard Stockton; George Walton; and William Whipple. Those 56 men placed their property, families, and their own lives at risk by affixing their signatures to that document. When it comes to the Constitution, once again at least nine of the signers can be conclusively documented as Freemasons: Gunning Bedford Jr.; John Blair; David Brearly; Jacob Broom; Daniel Carrol; John Dickinson; Benjamin Franklin; Rufus King; and George Washington.

Taking pride in your national and Masonic heritages should not be limited to this one holiday but for every day of your lives along with the lessons learned during each of the three Masonic degrees.


