Greetings, my Brothers,

First of all, some announcements:

As you all know by now, Called and Stated Communications have been called off due to the COVID-19 pandemics. While that emergency lasts, and following the desire of the Craft to continue working, we will have bi-weekly meetings via conference phone bridge and teleconferencing, to coincide with the dates where our Communications were to be held, so that we can carry on fraternal activities, discuss Masonic subjects, and share time together. The connection details will be communicated via email and text.

Secondly, some historical perspective relative to the current situation: It was 102 years ago, in 1918—while the world was still engulfed in World War I— when Masons throughout the world had to interrupt their Called and Stated Communications due to the outbreak of what was going to be the first recognized pandemic, caused by an especially strong strain of the influenza virus, then nicknamed as the "Spanish Flu". On October 7, 1918, the Grand Lodge of DC, with Masonic jurisdiction over our Nation's capital, issued a decree to "discontinue the communications of the constituent lodges... until further notice." (1) It wasn't the first, and it would not be the last jurisdiction forced to call off its gatherings. One county after another, first across most States East of the Mississippi River, and eventually across much of the country and the world, came to face the same situation.

But throughout it all, Masons everywhere assisted the efforts to combat the disease and provide for the affected: Countless Masonic Lodges and buildings were turned into makeshift hospitals or infirmaries, and legions of our brethren worked actively to help improve sanitary conditions and provide assistance in their communities.

Today we face a pandemic of similar proportions, and as before, we as Masons are called to help our brothers and sisters, within and without our Fraternity, to weather this crisis. Let's look out for each other, and for those who find themselves alone, defenseless and forgotten.

DIRECTIVE NO. 3

March 17, 2020

To: All Worshipful Masters and Secretaries of the Particular Lodges
