My dear Brothers,

I would like to first congratulate all the new Worshipful Masters of our Masonic District and their respective lines. I know you will perform your duties in excellent fashion and continue improving our Masonic ritual performances at each of your lodges. As always, I will be providing some Masonic education for the purpose of our continued enlightenment. This month I would like to discuss the Fellow Craft Degree in simple form to get a fundamental perspective into its meanings.

So far, we passed from the Entered Apprentice where we were neophytes (childhood) to the next level where we acquired more light and became (allegedly) more knowledgeable of who we are relative to humanity and our controls of our passions in the task of improving our soul's journey. According to Booklet number 3 of our Masonic Education (GL-204, 2010), "Where the Entered Apprentice represents youth standing at the portals of life, his eyes on the rising sun, where the Master Mason stands as the man of years, already on the farther slope of the hill with the setting sun in his eyes, the Fellow Craft is a man in the prime of life-experience, strong, resourceful, able to bear the heat and burden of the day."

The importance of this degree is that the Fellow Craft must gain direct experience. He is provided guidance regarding the five senses and must use them to learn about his surroundings. This experience is solely obtained through time and experiences. Though the period between Fellow Craft and Master Mason is generally 2 thru 6 months in our jurisdictions, the reality is that we don't expect anyone to achieve the fulfillment of the experiences and knowledge in such short a time. It is the responsibility of each of us to continue our research, practice of our rituals and explore their meanings, and learn how to control our passions through the study of liberal arts, contemplation of our daily actions, and reflection how our spiritual building is being constructed.

The Fellow Craft Degree is one of more light (education and learning). Please note that I split light (gnosis) into education and learning. We can read all the books we find on Masonry but without the application of the knowledge we do not mature and grow. I have found that one benefit of Masonry is the teachings of reflection, introspection, and responsibilities in drafting, engineering, and building our spiritual temple. GL-204 (2010) hints at this by stating, "Could we learn of life only that with which we are brought into contact by our own senses, then would we be indeed poorly equipped to deal with its complexities and responsibilities? No!" It goes further in the next sentence and I recommend that all read page 5 of the GL-204. The third answer to the gaining of experience and knowledge is wisdom. The key to gaining wisdom is understanding and enjoying the life one is provided.

Remember that we are in the middle chamber during this process. To achieve the middle chamber, we proceeded through two beautiful brazen pillars. Those pillars are said to have contained the written knowledge of Freemasonry. The we go up a flight of winding steps that illuminate the knowledge being gleaned from our studies and experiences. Wisdom is achieved when we knit together what we learned to form a unity that is balanced, poised, and adequate for our specific decision. In some cases, we can achieve greater than adequate but not at the expense of balance.

I hope this segment of explanations provided you with further ammunition for introspection and meditation. I hope to see you all at our next Open Books. We hold them every first Wednesday and third Monday of each month.

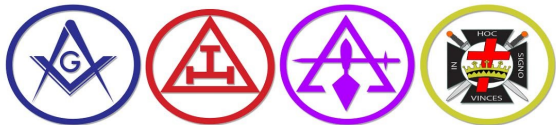
